The impact of today's barbaric tragedy has been significantly limited by the calmness and courage demonstrated by those who work on London's Underground, buses and the national rail network and the support they have received from the wider public.

'I have no doubt that once we piece together the full story of today's savage and dark events the way in which everyone who makes London's transport work did their duty, supported by a public that did not lose its nerve, will be clearly revealed,' says Adrian Lyons, Director General of The Railway Forum. 'We should not be subject to such acts of terrorism but the fact that there has been such commitment and professionalism shown in getting people out of danger and saving lives deserves the greatest admiration.'
